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## A Week at A Glance...10/16/2017 - 10/20/2017

Today, October 16, 2017, the Church celebrates the feast of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. Margaret Mary was born in France in 1647. As a child she became ill with rheumatic fever and was bedridden from the age of five until she was fifteen. During this time Margaret Mary developed a special devotion to Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. At the age of twenty, she began to experience visions of Christ.

When Margaret Mary was twenty-four, she entered **The Visitation Convent.** This order of religious sisters remains to this day. It is a cloistered order which means they are enclosed in a monastery. They withdraw from society to devote themselves to prayer and contemplation. Today, a **Visitation Convent** can be found in Tyringham, MA. The sisters do welcome visitors during times of public prayer. Check it out on the Web.

While at the convent, On December 21, 1674, Jesus began to share a series of revelations with Margaret Mary that would continue for the next year and a half. In them He informed her that she was His chosen Instrument to spread devotion to His **Sacred Heart**. Jesus wanted His Human Heart to be a symbol of His Divine-Human Love. Jesus then showed Margaret Mary His Sacred Heart. It was encircled by a crown of thorns, the symbol of His great sacrifice for us.

Jesus instructed Margaret Mary in a devotion that was to become known as the "*Nine Fridays and the Holy Hour*." Jesus asked that the **Feast of the Sacred Heart** be established. Today, this wonderful devotion to the Sacred Heart is celebrated throughout the world. It is commonly known as First Friday Devotions. On nine consecutive Fridays, Mass and Holy Communion are to be received in honor of Jesus' Sacred Heart.

Our Lord made twelve promises to Saint Margaret Mary for those who are devoted to His Sacred Heart and follow His request.

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3. I will comfort them in their afflictions.
- 4. I will be their source of refuge in life and in death.
- 5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners will find in My Heart the source and ocean of Mercy.
- 7. Lukewarm souls will become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall mount to perfection.
- 9. I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart is exposed and honored.
- 10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who shall promote this devotion will have their names written in My Heart.
- 12. I promise you in the excessive Mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance. My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in their last moments.

Our school children attend First Friday Mass each month during the academic year. How blessed they are to have this gift. What a wonderful treasure it is for them to be able to freely learn about The Sacred Heart Devotion. Perhaps you might join them at these Masses on the First Friday's of the month at 8:30 AM. You will be glad you did! *Oh most Sacred Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing...*
