The students did a great job in competing in the Battle of the Books. We congratulate all of the students for a job well done.



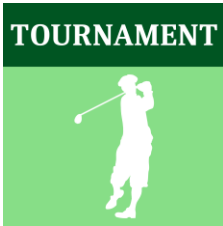
